The 2006 – 2007 school year was a year where the Hanover Education Foundation reached new heights in serving the both students and educators. At year's end, the HEF had provided total funding of over \$612,000.

A few of the year's highlights were the awarding of \$52,700 in scholarships to 33 students, once again sponsoring the Oak Knoll Elementary School's Odyssey of the Mind team as they competed in the world finals, and providing over \$41,000 in Creative Instructional Grants to 38 educators to enhance their classroom instruction. These activities enabled us to reach more students and educators in these areas than any previous year.

The foundation and Liberty Middle School were the recipient of over \$370,800 from the McGettigan Foundation and its founder and President, Mr. Patrick H. McGettigan. This donation funded the expansion of "Smart Board" technology throughout Liberty. The foundation thanks Mr. McGettigan for his generous donation.

Hanover County once again recognized its educators during the 8th Annual Celebration of Excellence. This is an evening set aside that allows us to show our appreciation to one of Hanover County's most important assets, our educators. The Celebration would not be possible without the support of our sponsors. The foundation wishes to thank them for all they do.

Contributions to the foundation come in many forms. Donations are received through the United Way, from direct personal donations, and business sponsorships. The foundation appreciates each and every gift we receive. During this year's Bowl for Education, our fourth year, over \$22,000 was raised from both business and individual sponsorships.

In closing I would like to express my appreciation to the Board of Directors for their work on behalf of the foundation. I would be remiss if I didn't acknowledge the work of Mr. Jacques Beauchesne who completed his second term on the Board during this past year. We also welcomed Joe Cox, Elizabeth Littlefield, Richard McDonnell and Michael Rosser who joined the Board during the past year and are already engaged in taking the Foundation to new heights. Finally, I want to acknowledge Margaret Hill, the Foundations Executive Director, for her support and tireless work on the Foundations behalf.

Being the president of the foundation for the last two years has been personally rewarding. I consider it both an honor and privilege to have led an organization that continues to engage the education of our county's youth.

**Taylor Receives Superintendent's Professional Development Award**



The Superintendent's Professional Development Grant is awarded annually for \$1,000 in honor of Dr. Stewart Roberson for being recognized as the 2000 Virginia Superintendent of the Year. This grant is awarded to a promising classroom teacher to support tuition, books, travel and other activities related to professional development.

The Hanover Education Foundation (HEF) has awarded the 2006-2007 Superintendent's Professional Development Scholarship to Melissa Taylor, who is a K-5 art teacher at Cool Spring Elementary School.

Ms. Taylor (pictured, third from left) will use the \$1,000 grant to enroll in a bookmaking workshop at Penland School of Crafts in Penland, North Carolina. Her goal is to teach the art of bookmaking to her students so that they can create an original journal. Her plan is to work with fifth grade classroom teachers and the reading resource teacher at Cool Spring to encourage students' writing skills.

The Superintendent's Professional Development Scholarship was initiated by the HEF in 1999. The HEF continues to award the scholarship annually to a promising classroom teacher. The 2007 award was made at the January 9 meeting of the Hanover County School Board.

# Hanover Education Foundation Hosts 4th Bowl-for-Education Event

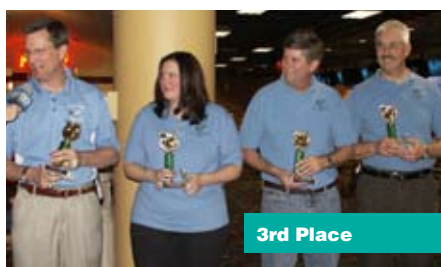
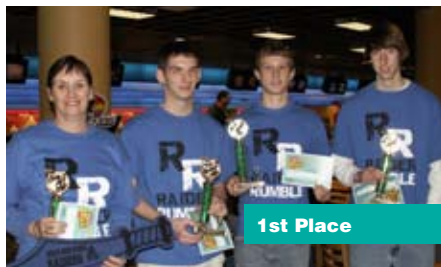

Odyssey of the Mind is an international educational program that provides creative problem-solving opportunities for students from kindergarten through college. Students apply their creativity to solve programs that range from building mechanical devices to presenting their own interpretation of literary classics. An Oak Knoll Middle School Odyssey of the Mind team recently joined students from around the world to compete in the 28th Odyssey of the Mind Finals, which were held at Michigan State University on May 23-26, 2007.

The students and their coaches worked hard all year perfecting their solution to their OM problem, Around the World in 8 Minutes. They competed and won at the region and state levels in order to advance to the 2007 World Finals. They placed first by 12 points in the spontaneous component of the competition, which they performed for the Board at the May School Board meeting.

The Hanover County School Board and Superintendent announced that the OKMS team placed second in their division in the Odyssey of the Mind 2007 World Tournament.

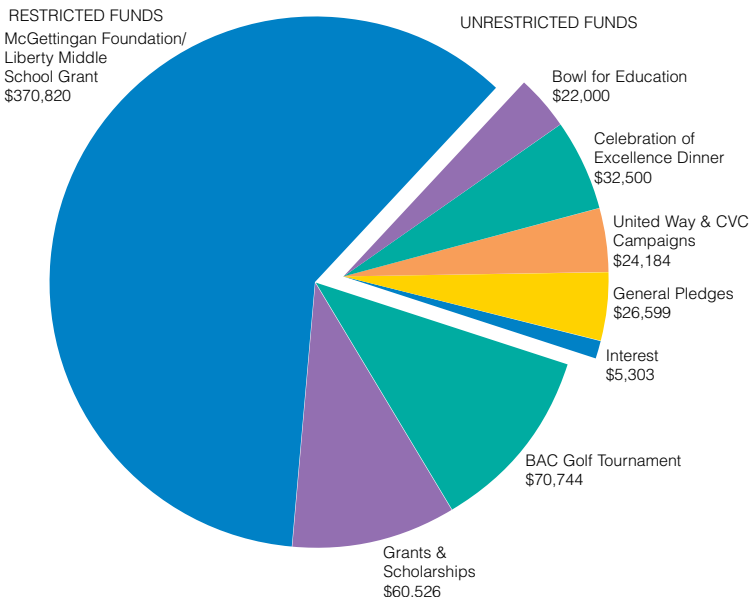

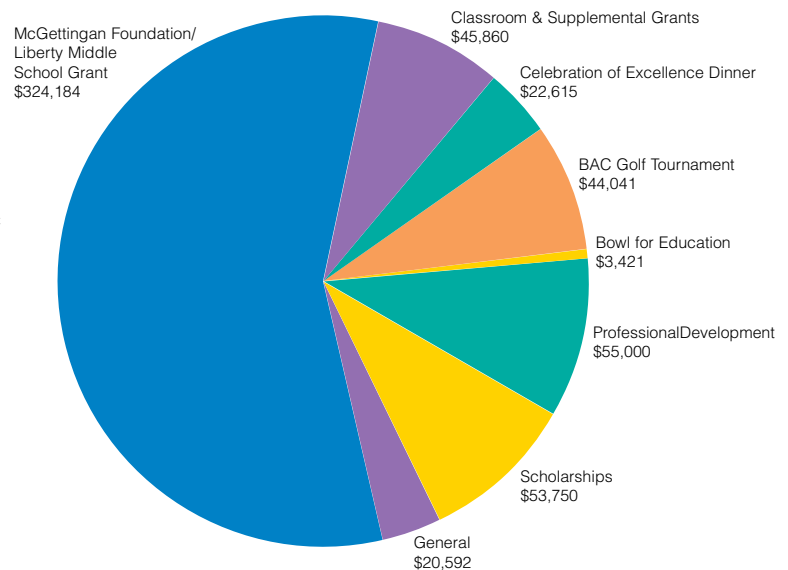
